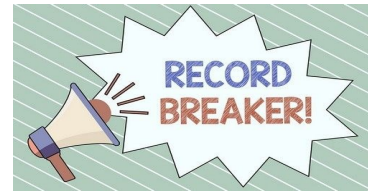
MARCH SAINT OF THE MONTH - ST. CASIMIR

The centuries-old St. Casimir's Fair, Kaziuko Muge, stretches throughout the old town with stalls selling hard bagels on a string, baronkos, dried feathers and flowers on a stick, verbos, which are Lithuanian version of palms used on Palm Sunday, handmade meats, cheeses and honey, textiles, crafts and sweets for the children. The fair serves as a celebration of spring's arrival and showcases a rich tapestry of Lithuanian customs and traditions.
