As George Washington himself prayed in the snows of Valley Forge begging for God's light, protection, grace and guidance, so also, we are called to pray for our nation during this historic anniversary asking for God's protection and forgiveness. Reminding ourselves that the only way to preserve this union and know any peace in our land is by returning to God.

Abraham Lincoln, in the midst of the civil war, in 1863, called on the entire nation to pray and fast and ask God's forgiveness and blessings for peace. It would be good for us to once again look upon and meditate on the words that Lincoln wrote to the nation over 150 years ago and ask ourselves - *"shouldn't we be doing the same now?"*

Excerpts from Abraham Lincoln's proclamation calling for a day of prayer and fasting on April 30th, 1863:

Whereas it is the duty of nations as well as of men to own their dependence upon the overruling power of God, to confess their sins and transgressions in humble sorrow, yet with assured hope that genuine repentance will lead to mercy and pardon, and to recognize the sublime truth, announced in the Holy Scriptures and proven by all history, that those nations only are blessed whose God is the Lord;

And, insomuch as we know that by His divine law nations, like individuals, are subjected to punishments and chastisements in this world, may we not justly fear that the awful calamity of civil war which now desolates the land may be but a punishment inflicted upon us for our presumptuous sins, to the needful end of our national reformation as a whole people? We have been the recipients of the choicest bounties of Heaven; we have been preserved these many years in peace and prosperity; we have grown in numbers, wealth, and power as no other nation has ever grown. But we have forgotten God. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us, and we have vainly imagined, in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom and virtue of our own. Intoxicated with unbroken success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too proud to pray to the God that made us.

It behooves us, then, to humble ourselves before the offended Power, to confess our national sins, and to pray for clemency and forgiveness.

All this being done in sincerity and truth, let us then rest humbly in the hope authorized by the divine teachings that the united cry of the nation will be heard on high and answered with blessings no less than the pardon of our national sins and the restoration of our now divided and suffering country to its former happy condition of unity and peace.

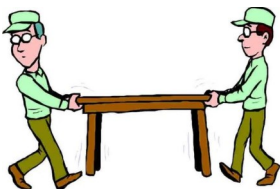
