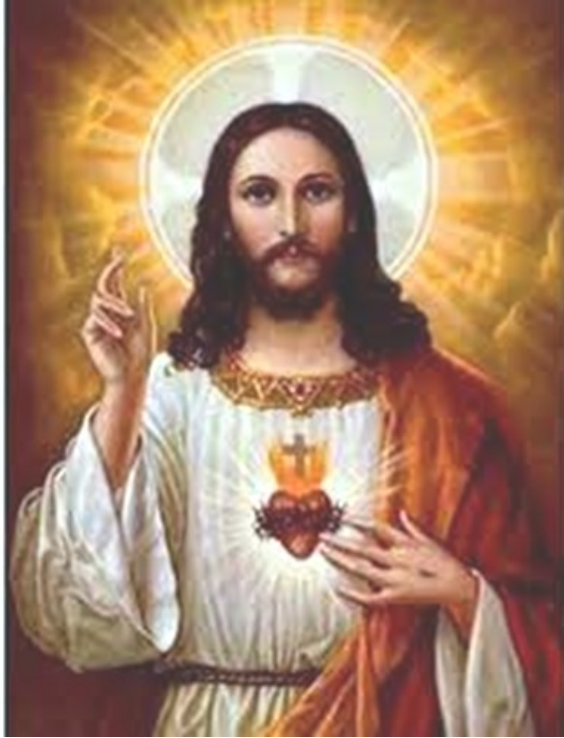

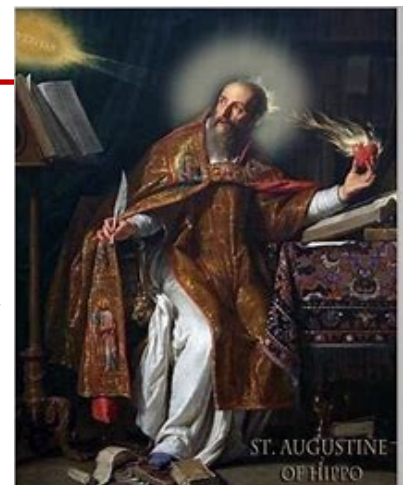

### **St. Augustine of Hippo – Feast Day August 28**

Born November 13, 354, Tagaste, Numidia, now Souk Ahras, Algeria—died August 28, 430, Hippo Regius, now Annaba, Algeria

St Augustine was the son of St Monica and Patricius. He was sent to Carthage to develop his talents and become a man of culture. Augustine initially rejected the faith his mother had taught him and lived an immoral life, but eventually became a great saint, priest, founder of many monasteries, Bishop of Hippo, a great theologian, and one of the greatest Doctors of the Church. St. Monica's resilience and dedication to prayer is what led Augustine to become the man of God he was meant to be.

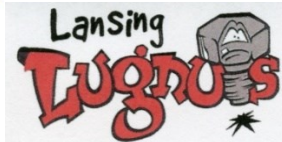
