SAINT OF THE MONTH - ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA

- Feast Day - June 13th

St. Anthony of Padua's tongue is a relic that is venerated in the Basilica of Padua, Italy. The tongue is kept in a gold reliquary along with the saint's jaw bone, while the rest of his remains are in a separate chapel.

According to legend, when St. Anthony's body was exhumed 30 years after his death in 1231, it had completely decomposed, except for his tongue, which was said to be wet and incorrupt, and even glistened as if it were still part of a living body. Some say this was a miracle that showed God's regard for St. Anthony's tongue, which was used to preach the Gospel and touch many hearts. The Basilica celebrates the discovery of the tongue with a feast on February 28, which is the second most important feast of the year for St. Anthony.
